### CLOTHING

12 - 14 short sleeved or sleeveless tops  
2 long sleeved tops  
2 sweatshirts  
6 pairs of shorts  
4 pairs of pants  
14 pairs of underwear  
12 pairs of socks  
2 pairs of pyjamas  
4 swimsuits

1 bathrobe  
1 warm rain jacket  
2 pairs of running shoes  
2 pairs of sandals or flip-flops  
1 pair of rain boots  
4 baseball hats (visors are not acceptable)  
2 pairs of sunglasses  
1 kippa  
2 special outfits for Shabbat

\*Giborim Campers should reduce all clothing amounts by 50%

### TOILETRIES

1 shower caddy  
1 bottle of liquid soap  
1 bottle of shampoo  
1 bottle of conditioner  
1 toothbrush in a case  
1 tube of toothpaste  
1 comb/brush  
1 package of hair elastics  
2 bottles of sunscreen  
2 bottles of mosquito repellent.

### BEDDING & TOWELS

2 fitted sheets  
1 flat sheet  
1 blanket  
1 pillow  
2 pillow cases  
4 beach towels  
3 bath towels  
1 mesh laundry bag  
1 sleeping bag (Grade 5 and older only)

### OTHER

Water bottles, writing paper, pre-addressed & stamped envelopes, pens and a flashlight with batteries

## PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING POLICIES:

Electronics have become a very important part of our daily lives. While we appreciate the value they provide, we also feel that camp offers the perfect (and important) opportunity for children to 'un-plug.' This allows them to focus their time and energy on enhancing their camp experience. With this in mind, Camp Hatikvah has developed the following list of acceptable and prohibited electronic devices. Please review it carefully with your children. Your understanding and support of this policy is greatly appreciated.

### The following devices are prohibited at Camp:

- Any device capable of connecting to wifi, a cellular network or making telephone calls
- Any device capable of watching movies, TV shows or videos
- iPad
- iPod Touch

### The following electronic devices are permitted at Camp:

- iPod Shuffle
- iPod Mini
- Small, lightweight and inexpensive digital cameras
- Any Electronic reading devices (Kobo, Kindle, etc)

Please assume that all devices not found on the approved list of electronic devices above are considered prohibited. If a camper is found with a prohibited device, the item will be confiscated and NOT returned.

Camp Hatikvah does not assume responsibility for any lost, broken or stolen items. As a general rule, anything valuable that a camper would be upset if lost, broken, ruined or stolen should not be brought to camp.

Please also note that knives, weapons, tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, illegal drugs, vaping supplies & materials, hot pots, matches, fireworks, lighters, butane, incense and candles are all banned substances and materials at Camp Hatikvah . Possession of any of these items may lead to immediate dismissal from camp as per our camp policies.

Please do not send your children to Camp with extra food. We have many children with severe (and often life-threatening) allergies. Thus, all food consumed at Camp must come directly from our dining facility.
